

INTERMODAL TRAILER



Intermodal semi trailers are designed to transport palletized shipments which require a fully enclosed trailer. Intermodal containers are specifically useful for products with no time sensitivity in order to capture the cost savings of rail transit. These cost savings are the most substantial when shipping in/out of major market lanes over 1,500 miles.
